**Gal 5:1-6** “For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery. 2 Look: I, Paul, say to you that if you accept circumcision, Christ will be of no advantage to you. 3 I testify again to every man who accepts circumcision that he is obligated to keep the whole law. 4 You are severed from Christ, you who would be justified by the law; you have fallen away from grace. 5 For through the Spirit, by faith, we ourselves eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness. 6 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, but only faith working through love.”

The greatness of the price paid to love a person.

**Jhn 15:13** “Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends.”

The greatness of the good that is done  
for the person when he is loved.

**John 3:16** “For God so loved the world,  
that he gave his only Son, that whoever  
believes in him should not perish but  
have eternal life.”

The level of desire that God has for the good of the one loved.

**Zeph 3:17** “The Lord your God is in your midst, a mighty one who will save; he will rejoice over you with gladness; he will quiet you by his love; he will exult over you with loud singing.”

Rom 10:17

“So, faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.”

**Micah 7:8-9** “Rejoice not over me, O my enemy; when I fall, I shall rise; when I sit in darkness, the Lord will be a light to me. I will bear the indignation of the Lord because I have sinned against him, until he pleads my cause and executes judgment for me. He will bring me out to the light; I shall look upon his vindication.”
