- **Premise one:** God in Christ purposed to save all men (there is no limit in the purpose or design of the atonement).
- **Premise two:** Christ's atonement has provided everything necessary for salvation (i.e., there is no limit in the power of the atonement).
- **Conclusion:** All men will be saved.
