

Isa 19:25 "the Lord of hosts has blessed, saying, "Blessed be Egypt my people, and Assyria the work of my hands, and Israel

my inheritance."



Jonah 4:9-11 "God said to Jonah, "Do you do well to be angry for the plant?" And he said, "Yes, I do well to be angry, angry enough to die." 10 And the Lord said, "You pity the plant, for which you did not labor, nor did you make it grow, which came into being in a night and perished in a night. 11 And should not I pity Nineveh, that great city, in which there are more than 120,000 persons who do not know their right hand from their left, and also much cattle?"

Matt 21:33-43 "Hear another parable. There was a master of a house (who?) who planted a vineyard (what?) and put a fence around it and dug a winepress in it and built a tower and leased it to tenants (who?), and went into another country. 34 When the season for fruit drew near, he sent his servants to the tenants to get his fruit. 35 And the tenants took his servants and beat one, killed another, and stoned another. 36 Again he sent other servants, more than the first. And they did the same to them. 37 Finally he sent his son to them, saying, 'They will respect my son.' 38 But when the tenants saw the son, they said to themselves, 'This is the heir. Come, let us kill him and have his inheritance.'

39 And they took him and threw him out of the vineyard and killed him. 40 When therefore the owner of the vineyard comes, what will he do to those tenants?" 41 They said to him, "He will put those wretches to a miserable death and let out the vineyard to other tenants who will give him the fruits in their seasons.".... 43 Therefore I tell you, the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people producing its

Gal 4:1-7 "I mean that the heir, as long as he is a child, is no different from a slave, though he is the owner of everything, 2 but he is under guardians and managers until the date set by his father. 3 In the same way we also, when we were children, were enslaved to the elementary principles of the world. 4 But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, 5 to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. 6 And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" 7 So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God."

V4 "But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law...."

John 6:38 "For I have come down from heaven, not to do my own will but the will of him who sent me."

1 John 4:9 "God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him."

Col 1:13, 19, 2:9 "He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son... For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell......In him the whole fullness of deity dwells bodily..."

John 1:1-3,14 "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made through him, and without him was not anything made that was made....14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth." ESV

Heb 1:3 "He is the <u>radiance</u> of the glory of God and the <u>exact imprint</u> of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power."

V4 "But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law...."

Lk 1:35 "The angel answered, 'The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So, the holy one to be born will be called the Son of God.'"

During His trial before the Jewish leaders, the High Priest demanded of Jesus, Matt 26:63-67 "I adjure you by the living God, tell us if you are the Christ, the Son of God." 64 Jesus said to him, "You have said so. But I tell you, from now on you will see the Son of Man seated at the right hand of Power and coming on the clouds of heaven." 65 Then the high priest tore his robes and said, "He has uttered blasphemy. What further witnesses do we need? You have now heard his blasphemy. 66 What is your judgment?"

They answered, "He deserves death."

John 19:7 "The Jews insisted, 'We have a law, and according to that law He must die, because He claimed to be the Son of God."

Jhn 5:17 "My Father is working until now, and I am working"

Jhn 5:18 "This was why the Jews were seeking all the more to kill him, because not only was he breaking the Sabbath, but he was even calling God his own Father, making himself equal with God".

Jhn 19:6-7 "Pilate said to them, "Take him yourselves and crucify him, for I find no guilt in him." The Jews answered him, "We have a law, and according to that law he ought to die because he has made himself the Son of God."

Lev 24:16 "Whoever blasphemes the name of the Lord shall surely be put to death."

John 10:30-33 "Jesus said "I and the Father are One." The Jews immediately picked up stones—not because He said He was a prophet, but because He made Himself equal with God. Their response wasn't confusion; it was outrage. They explicitly told Him, "You, being a man, make Yourself God." They understood the claim clearly, even if modern people choose to ignore it."

John 20:31, John says: "these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name."
