Gal 2:20 “I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God who loved me and gave Himself for me .”

Ro 6:5 “If we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his.”

Ro 6:4 “We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life.”

Gal 5:24: “Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.”

Gal 6:14 “Far be it from me to boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.”



Truth 1 - We're not just echoing or conforming or mirroring the standards of the world, which means that our sin is broken.

Ro 6:7: "For one who has died has been set free from sin."

Ro 6:11 "So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus."

Ro 6:13: “Present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness.”

2 Cor 4:10 “[We are] always carrying in the body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be manifested in our bodies.”

2 Cor 2:14 “But thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of him everywhere.”



2 Cor 3:18. “We all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit”
