

Ezekiel 43:12-14

12 This is the law of the temple: the whole territory on the top of the mountain all around shall be most holy. Behold, this is the law of the temple. 13 These are the measurements of the altar by cubits (the cubit being a cult and a handbreadth) its base shall be one cubit high and one cubit broad, with a rim of one span around its edge. And this shall be the height of the altar: 14 from the base on the ground to the lower ledge, two cubits, with a breadth of one cubit; and from the smaller ledge to the larger ledge, four cubits, with a breadth of one cubit.

LIFEGROUP CONVERSATION

- 1. In verse 13, God changed the cubit from 6 handbreadths to 7 handbreadths. Chance referred to this as the seventh hand. What does the seventh hand represent?
- 2. What is the Holy Spirit role?
- 3. How essential is the Holy Spirit for Christian living?
- 4. How have you experienced the Holy Spirit in your life, even if you didn't know at the time that it was him?

Read Romans 8:1-11.

- 5. How can someone know if they are being led by God's Spirit or not?
- 6. Are you guilty of trying to do things in your own power? What are practical ways to make sure we are being led by the Spirit?
