And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

The Spirit of God won't fill you if you are already full of yourself.

If you're a follower of Jesus, you are a dead man walking.

We must deny ourselves.

The result of denying self is not to be a more rule-abiding person, but a more Christabiding follower of Jesus.

Carry your cross.

The world doesn't need uncrucified Christians.

If you aren't killing sin then it's killing you.

Serve others faithfully.
