Start Talking. Conversation starter for your group.

• What is the best gift you have ever received from someone in the local church? What made it so great?

Start Thinking.

- Read <u>1 Corinthians 12:1-7</u>. Why did Paul want the Corinthian Church to understand spiritual gifts? Do you think there is a misunderstanding of Spiritual gifts in today's Church? Why or why not?
- What does verse 7 indicate to you? Why is this verse important for you to know?
- Read **1** Corinthians **12:12-26**. What do these verses reveal about yourself? About others?
- Do you find it hard not to judge or compare yourself to other people and their gifts? Why or why not?

Start Sharing.

- How does knowing that the Holy Spirit has given a spiritual gift just for you affect the way you view yourself and your relationship with God?
- Read the following passages: 1 Corinthians 12:8-10, 1 Corinthians 12:28, Romans 12:6-8, Ephesians 4:11-12, and 1 Peter 4:10-11. What are your spiritual gifts? If you are not sure, what do you think your spiritual gifts might be? Have your group share what gifts they see in you.
- Read <u>1 Peter 4:10-11</u>. This passage encourages us to use our gifts to serve one another and to bring glory to God. Describe a time when you benefitted from someone using their spiritual gifts. How has God used your spiritual gifts to make an impact?
- Why is it so important (and necessary) for you to use your spiritual gifts?
