Start Talking. Conversation starter for your group.

- What fears do you have when it comes to sharing your faith?

Start Thinking.

- Read Matthew 28:18-20
 - In Matthew 28:18-20 we find what is known as the Great Commission. What is the main commandment that Jesus is giving His disciples? What are the three sub-commandments?
 - How are they to make disciples? With what resources? What is the ultimate goal of the disciple-making process?
 - What does Jesus promise in these verses? How much authority does Jesus have to offer His disciples in this process?
- Read Mark 12:28-31
 - In response to a question from a law teacher, Jesus gives what is known as the Great Commandment. Jesus says that there are really two great commandments. What are they? Why are they so great?

Start Sharing.

- In what ways can you fulfill the Great Commission in the context of your family? Work? Community? What is keeping you from fulfilling the Great Commission?
- What do you need to do to love God more? What do you need to do to love people more? What is keeping you from keeping the Great Commandment?

Start Doing

- Where is God calling you to be an ambassador for Him?
- Is God calling you to any practical application? What positive steps can you take? Is there any active repentance necessary?
- Pray/Recite Ephesians 3:16-21
 - 'I pray that from his glorious, unlimited resources he will empower you with inner strength through his Spirit. Then Christ will make his home in your hearts as you trust in him. Your roots will grow down into God's love and keep you strong. And may you have the power to understand, as all God's people should, how wide, how long, how high, and how deep his love is. May you experience the love of Christ, though it is too great to

understand fully. Then you will be made complete with all the fullness of life and power that comes from God. Now all glory to God, who is able, through his mighty power at work within us, to accomplish infinitely more than we might ask or think. Glory to him in the church and in Christ Jesus through all generations forever and ever! Amen.'
