

# God Is For You

If you have ever wondered whether God is truly on your side, Romans 8 gives one of the clearest and most powerful answers in all of Scripture. God is not against you. He is not withholding from you. He is fighting for you, and nothing can change that.

## Does God Really Care About What I Am Going Through?

It can be easy to feel like God is distant, especially in the middle of a hard season. But the truth is, He is deeply involved in your life. He is Jehovah Jireh, the God who sees ahead and provides. He has already seen what is coming in the days ahead, and He has already made a way.

Romans 8:31 puts it plainly: "What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?" That is not a motivational phrase. It is a settled truth.

## What Does It Mean That God Is "For" Me?

God is for everyone who is still breathing. No matter how far someone has wandered, the fact that they are still alive is evidence that God has not given up on them. If that is true for the most broken person imaginable, how much more is it true for someone who is seeking Him?

Romans 8:32 takes it even further: "He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?" If God gave you His Son, what could He possibly withhold from you? He already gave you the greatest gift. Everything else is included.

## Why Do We Struggle to Receive God's Love?

The problem is rarely that God is withholding. The problem is that we resist. When we fill our lives with things that make us more flesh-conscious than Spirit-conscious, we do not lose God's love, but we lose our awareness of it. It is like walking from a dark room into a bright one. The light is real, but you are temporarily blinded.

God's love does not change based on your performance. What changes is your ability to recognize it. The goal is to develop what could be called a love consciousness, a deep, settled awareness of how much God is for you, with you, and working on your behalf.

## **Who Can Accuse You Before God?**

In the book of Job, Satan came before God and accused Job. He had legal access to do so because Adam had surrendered dominion over the earth to him. Satan became, as Revelation 12 describes, the accuser of the brethren, accusing them before God day and night.

But something changed at the resurrection of Jesus. Revelation 12:10 declares: "Now salvation and strength and the kingdom of our God and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down."

The accuser has been removed from his seat. Jesus now sits at the right hand of the Father, not as a prosecutor, but as an intercessor. Romans 8:34 says He "is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us."

## **How Does the Blood of Jesus Protect Me From Accusation?**

Revelation 12:11 tells us: "They overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony." When the enemy tries to bring a charge against you, the answer is the blood of Jesus. You do not have to build a case or prove your worth. The blood has already washed you clean.

Romans 8:33-34 asks: "Who shall bring a charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us."

You have been declared righteous. You have been justified. Stop measuring your standing before God by your good days and bad days and start putting your confidence in the finished work of the cross.

## **Can Anything Separate Me From God's Love?**

**Romans 8:35-39 gives the definitive answer:**

- Not tribulation
- Not distress
- Not persecution
- Not famine
- Not peril
- Not death or life
- Not angels or principalities
- Not things present or things to come
- Not height or depth
- Not any created thing

"For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord." - Romans 8:38-39

The only thing that can separate you from His love is your own rejection of it. And that is entirely your choice.

## **What Does It Mean to Be More Than a Conqueror?**

Romans 8:37 says: "Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us." Not conquerors after the trial is over. More than conquerors in the middle of it. The trial does not disqualify you from God's blessing. In fact, when you come through it with your faith intact, you come out stronger, more convinced of His faithfulness, and positioned for even greater blessing.

Job lost everything and came out with twice what he had before. The enemy will regret attacking you when God is done with the situation.

## **How Do I Actually Live Like God Is For Me?**

The key is persuasion. Not just knowing these truths intellectually, but being fully convinced of them. When the enemy whispers that God is not going to help you this time, that you are on the naughty list, that this situation is too far gone, the answer is to come back to what the Word says.

Faith works by love. You do not have to strive and strain to make God move. You simply must stop resisting and start receiving. Be a receiver of His love. Let it do its work in you. Plead the blood when accusation comes. Speak His Word when doubt rises. Trust that He who did not spare His own Son will freely give you everything else you need.

## **Life Application**

This week, practice becoming a receiver instead of a resister. Each morning, take a moment to declare out loud: "God is for me. Nothing can separate me from His love. I receive His love today." When fear, guilt, or accusation rises up, respond with the blood of Jesus and the truth of Romans 8 rather than trying to argue your case or prove your worth.

## **Ask yourself these questions as you go through your week:**

- Am I living like God is truly for me, or am I secretly waiting for Him to give up on me?
- Where in my life am I resisting God's love rather than receiving it?

- When accusation or condemnation comes, am I turning to the blood of Jesus and the finished work of the cross, or am I trying to earn my way back into God's good graces?
- What would change in my daily life if I was fully persuaded that nothing could separate me from the love of God?

God has not moved. His love is still flowing. His intercession is still active on your behalf. The accuser has been cast down, and Jesus sits at the right hand of the Father making intercession for you right now. You are more than a conqueror. Start living like it.
