

## **Secure, Seated, and Unmoved: A Woman Who Knows Her Place**

In a world full of chaos and uncertainty, God is raising up women who are secure, seated, and unmoved - women who know their place in Christ. This isn't about physical positioning, but about understanding our spiritual identity and authority as daughters of the King.

### **What Does It Mean to Be Seated with Christ?**

Many believers still see themselves spiritually down here, trying to reach God, trying to get His attention, or striving to attain a position they think they need. But Scripture reveals a different reality.

### **You've Already Been Raised and Seated**

Ephesians 2:4-6 tells us that God "made us alive together with Christ... and raised us up together and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus." Notice the past tense language - you have been raised and you have been made to sit. This isn't something you're trying to achieve; it's something that has already been accomplished.

When we understand this truth, we realize we're not trying to climb higher spiritually. We're not struggling to impress God or earn our way to a better position. We have already been seated with Christ in heavenly places.

### **Positioned Above the Problem**

Ephesians 1:20-21 shows us that Christ is "seated at his right hand in the heavenly places far above all principality and power and might and dominion and every name that is named." Since we're seated with Him, we are positioned above the problem, not underneath it.

This means you can't be "under attack" when the devil is under your feet. While circumstances might look or feel overwhelming, the spiritual reality is that you're seated in a position of authority with Christ.

## **How Do We Stay in Our Position?**

Knowing our position is one thing, but staying there is another. The word "STAY" provides a helpful framework:

### **S - Seated**

Remember that you're not trying to attain a seat - you've been given one. Picture yourself there. You're not striving or struggling; you're resting in the position Christ has provided.

### **T - Tethered**

Hebrews 6:19 describes hope as "an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast." When you're tethered to Christ, you're not easily knocked around by life's storms. A ship that is anchored doesn't drift with the current.

You stay tethered in bad weather. No matter what kind of waves roar or winds blow, you know you're not going anywhere because you're anchored in Him.

### **A - Authority**

Authority has been given to you through your position in Christ. Think of a police officer directing traffic - it's not their physical strength that stops cars, but the authority represented by their badge. Similarly, your spiritual authority doesn't come from your own strength but from the position you've been given.

Matthew 28:18-19 records Jesus saying, "All authority has been given to me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore..." Because we have Him and He is in us, we carry that same authority.

## **Y - Yielding**

Romans 6:13 encourages us to "present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead and your members as instruments of righteousness to God." Yielding means saying, "Lord, I belong to you. My life is yours."

## **Why Is Submission So Important?**

James 4:7 provides a powerful principle: "Submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you." Many people focus on the resisting part, but it starts with submission.

## **Submission Empowers Resistance**

When you submit to God, that submission empowers you to resist the devil. There is power in obedience. Too many believers are trying to resist the enemy in their own strength, but true power comes through submission to God first.

Your strength as a believer isn't found in how hard you fight, but in how firmly you remain in your position. It's not about fighting harder; it's about staying seated and submitted.

## **What Happens When We Know Our Place?**

When someone truly knows their place, they carry themselves differently. They're not:

- Striving for position
- Competing for recognition
- Shaken when circumstances shift

Instead, they remain secure and unmoved because their identity and security are anchored in Christ, not in changing circumstances.

## **Why Does This Matter Now?**

In these last days, God needs His daughters to take their seats as queens in the midst of a chaotic world. The world needs women who are secure, seated, and unmoved so they can fulfill their calling and purpose.

When you're recognized by the King of Kings Himself, you don't need anyone else's recognition. He will raise you up for His kingdom and His glory when it's all about Him and not just about you.

## **Life Application**

This week, practice staying in your God-given position. Instead of trying to work harder or fight more battles, focus on remaining seated, tethered, walking in authority, and yielded to God.

## **Consider these questions:**

- Am I trying to attain a position God has already given me?
- What unnecessary battles am I fighting that I should surrender to God?
- How can I better yield my decisions to God's wisdom rather than my own understanding?
- Where in my life do I need to submit more fully to God so I can resist the enemy's attacks?

Remember: You don't have to work harder to do better. You just need to work on staying in the position Christ has already provided. Live with unshakable confidence, knowing that your labor in the Lord is never in vain.
