## SURRENDER REQUIRES DIFFICULT DECISIONS

	Isaac was the son God Abraham and Sarah in their old age (Gen. 17:19; 18:10-14; 21:1-3).					
	Isaac was likely in his mid-20s when he went to (Gen. 22:5; 23:1; Antiquities 1.13.2).					
•	Even though this event occurred before the Law of Moses, a consumed fiery sacrifice was what God expected (Gen. 22:6-10; Lev. 1:3-9).					
	SURRENDER REQUIRES TRUST IN THE UNKNOWN					
	While Abraham questioned and pleaded with God on other occasions, here he follows God's command delay (cp. Gen. 18-19; 22:1-3).					
	Throughout the text, Abraham shows faith in God's plan even though it doesn't (Gen. 22:5, 8, 11-14).					
	Abraham believed God would fulfill His promise even if it required Isaac from the dead (Gen. 22:5: In. 8:56-58: Heb. 11:17-19)
