# WHEN CALLED TO SURRENDER

## SURRENDER REQUIRES DIFFICULT DECISIONS

- Isaac was the son God \_\_\_\_\_ Abraham and Sarah in their old age (Gen. 17:19; 18:10-14; 21:1-3).
- Isaac was likely in his mid-20s when he went to \_\_\_\_\_ (Gen. 22:5; 23:1; Antiquities 1.13.2).
- Even though this event occurred before the Law of Moses, a \_\_\_\_\_ consumed fiery sacrifice was what God expected (Gen. 22:6-10; Lev. 1:3-9).

## SURRENDER REQUIRES TRUST IN THE UNKNOWN

- While Abraham questioned and pleaded with God on other occasions, here he follows God's command \_\_\_\_\_ delay (cp. Gen. 18-19; 22:1-3).
- Throughout the text, Abraham shows faith in God's plan even though it doesn't \_\_\_\_\_ (Gen. 22:5, 8, 11-14).
- Abraham believed God would fulfill His promise even if it required \_\_\_\_\_ Isaac from the dead (Gen. 22:5; Jn. 8:56-58; Heb. 11:17-19).
