5 FACTS ABOUT JOSEPH

	Joseph was Jacob's favorite son. He was the eleventh son of Jacob and the first son of Rachel (Gen. 30:24; 33:2, 7; 37:3).	
	FAVORITISM	FAMILIES.
	Joseph was a source of controversy. His dreams and favored status created problems amongst his brothers (Gen. 37:2-11).	
	THERE IS A TIME TO A TIME TO KEEP	
	Joseph was betrayed and sold into slavery. His brothers sold him to traders and he ended up in Egypt (Gen. 37:23-28).	
	SOMETIMES THE PEOPLE ARE THE ONES WHO HUR	
	Joseph remained faithful in a foreign land. He resisted temptation and endured hardship (Gen. 37:2; 39:6-23; 41:46).

5 LESSONS FROM JOSEPH

"YOU DO NOT HAVE TO HEAR GOD'S TO TRUST HIS HAND."

-	We never read where God spoke directly to Joseph, but that "The Lord was with Joseph" (Gen. 39:2, 21, 23).
"(CHARACTER IS WHEN NO ONE IS WATCHING."
•	Joseph did what was right and resisted temptation when put in an difficult situation (Gen. 39:6-12)
	"GOD TURNS INTO STEPPING STONES."
•	Joseph's life in the pit and the dungeon were part of a greater plan (Gen. 37:24; 41:14; 45:5-8; 50:20).
	" SETS YOU FREE."
•	Joseph forgave and restored the very people who betrayed him (Gen. 45:1-15; 50:15-21)
	"JOSEPH POINTS US TO"
•	Joseph points to a greater Joseph who is rejected, betrayed, exalted, and ready to save (Gen. 45:7).

THE MYSTERIOUS MAN IN THE FIELD

This scene of Yoseph encountering a random man in the field is not random at all. If it were not for this man, Yoseph would not have found his brothers, and he would not have been kidnapped, sold as a slave, and taken to Egypt. Without going to Egypt, Yoseph would not have been discovered by Pharaoh and elevated as ruler of Egypt able to save his family from the famine. If Yoseph had not met this man, he and his entire family would have died in the famine. (The Bible Project Notes: Joseph.)
