•	Patterns of rebellion. The pattern of seeing, desiring, and taking spirals out of control (Gen. 3:6; 6:1-2).		
	UNCHECKED LEAI	DS TO DISOBEDIENCE.	
•	Hearts consumed with evil. The people of Noah's day were rotten from the inside out (Gen. 6:5; 8:21).		
	SIN BEGINS IN THE		
•	Widespread outbreak. Sin in Noah's time was like a spiritual pandemic that infected everything it touched (Gen. 6:11-12).		
When sin is, it spreads like a contagion.			
•	A grieved God. God is deeply troubled over humanity's rebellion (Gen. 6:6-7).
