The Kind of Life We Want to Avoid

- One that listens to the **wrong** voices (1:1b).
- One that **closely** associates w/ opposers of God (1:1c).
- One that is **comfortable** around mockers of God (1:1d).
- One that **ends** in separation from God (1:4-6).

Small steps from God lead to places you don't want to go.

The Kind of Life We Want to Enjoy

- One that finds **joy** in God's Word (1:2a).
- One that thinks **deeply** about Scripture (1:2b).
- One that is **planted** and thrives (1:3a).
- One that **prospers** in every season (1:3b).

The happy Life is more than what we give up and avoid.
