MADE TO BELONG

HOW WE FIT INTO THE CHURCH ROMANS 12:1-8



HINDRANCES TO BELONGING

- WORLDLINESS (Romans 12:1-2). Conforming to the values
 of the world makes it hard for the church to embrace
 you and for you to embrace the church.
- ARROGANCE (Romans 12:3). Thinking too highly of ourselves breaks unity and causes people to want to avoid us instead of approach us.
- INDIFFERENCE (Romans 12:4–8). Choosing to not use your gifts disconnects you from the life of the church and causes the body to weaken and suffer.
- ISOLATION (Romans 12:5). Believing you don't need others leads to spiritual loneliness and denies that the church is a "coherent unified social organism."

HELPS TO BELONGING

- HOLINESS (Romans 12:1-2). Offering our lives in service to the kingdom of God sets us apart for His purposes and draws us closer to His people.
- HUMILITY (Romans 12:3). Finding our identity in Christ is both humbling and encouraging. Grace reminds us we didn't earn our place and levels the playing field.
- SERVING (Romans 12:4–8). Using your gifts builds connection, strengthens others, and gives you a tangible sense of purpose within the local church.
- CONNECTION (Romans 12:5). Belonging grows when we see ourselves as part of something bigger than us. Mutual independence says, "we are members of one another."
