Of the 3 Crititical Points listed, B is the most dangerous ("If it's not broken, why fix it?"). During this period, the bills are paid and leaders are in place. The church has the tendency to stop taking risks, stop empowering new leaders, and focus more on tradition than transformation. Unless the church begins to take intentional risks to reach the lost, a period of slow decline will begin and the primary focus will be on keeping members happy, repairing the church building, and preserving what's familiar instead of pursuing what's fruitful.

| • | HIS DEATH CONVICTS US (5:14b). The truth that Jesus died "for" all reminds us that Jesus' death is extremely and essential to escape God's wrath and receive forgiveness (cp. Isa. 53:4-12; Gal. 3:13; Heb. 9:11-14). |
| • | HIS RESURRECTION CONSUMES US (5:4, 10, 15, 17). The resurrection of Jesus causes us to be with Christ and long to be further clothed after the judgment (cp.1 Cor. 15:46-58; Rom. 8:18-24; Phil. 3:21). |

2 CORINTHIANS 5:9-15

"Therefore we make it our aim, whether present or absent, to be well pleasing to Him. For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.
