c. 125 AD

LUCIAN

c. 170 AD

"THEIR FIRST LAWGIVER PERSUADED THEM THAT THEY ARE ALL BROTHERS... AND SO THEY LOVE ONE ANOTHER FROM THE MOMENT THEY ARE CONVERTED."

c. 260 AD

CHURCH HURT HEALING

Generally speaking, "the church doesn't hurt people, people hurt people"

CULPABILITY

ROMANS 12:9-10

We need to distinguish between emotional impact and actual moral or ethical wrongdoing.

Just because you got your feelings hurt doesn't mean someone wronged you.

APOLOGY

ROMANS 13:10: 14:15

I'm sorry if you found hurt in the church instead of hope.

If you carry hurt, we want to help you get something off your heart before we get something into your head.

RESPONSIBILITY

ROMANS 5:8-9

You can find hurt within a "church" context but you can also find healing.

Don't let what a few people in the church did to you keep you from what Jesus did for you.
