THE WORD OF GOD GIVES HOPE

THE BIBLE REVEALS HOPE

(1 Pet. 1:3-5; Phil. 3:20-21).

•	Biblical hope is not wishful thinking, but rooted in God's character (Num. 23:19; Tit. 1:2).
•	Hope is the expectation that God will do what He has promised (Jos. 21:43-45; 1 Kgs. 8:56).
•	By trusting God's unchanging word over our ever- changing world, we discover the hope it gave God's people before us (Lam. 3:21–24; Ps. 119:49–50, 81).
THE BIBLE REDIRECTS HOPE	
•	The world's hope is to what is seen and temporary (Ps. 20:7; 2 Cor. 4:16-18).
•	Scripture calls us toour confidence where the world never looks (Col. 3:1-4; Heb. 11:13-16).
•	True Christian hope us to an inheritance that is incorruptible, undefiled, and does not fade away

THE BIBLE RESTORES HOPE

Case study: Luke 4:16-21

- Hope declared: God's Word ______ a Savior who would bring good news to those who were broken, oppressed, and hurting (Isa. 61:1-2; Lk. 4:18).
 Hope delivered: The hope of God's Word wasn't just read,
- Hope discovered: Jesus' promises then are available _____ to all who come to Him (Mt. 11:28–30; Heb. 13:8).



READING

LUKE 4:16-21

"So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read. And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed; To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord." Then He closed the book, and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him. And He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."" (Luke 4:16-21, NKJV)
