
- **Possibility.** Ten years of \_\_\_\_\_ reach a boiling point in this drama (Gen. 12:1-4; 15:1-6; 16:3).

•	<b>Pain.</b> God acknowledged Hagar's by seeing her suffering and hearing her cries (Gen. 16:11; cp. Gen. 29:32; Ex. 3:7; 4:31; Deut. 26:7).
