

坐 A. Main Idea

- 1. The precious blood of Jesus is EVERYTHING!
- 2. If Satan had his way, no preacher would ever preach about the blood of Jesus.
- 3. If we go "bloodless" about our story, our testimony, our beliefs, our understanding of the gospel, our church, we are dead.
- 4. If we go "bloodless" in our understanding of Christianity, we will only have *Hot-tub Christianity*—we will feel good, but not be good.
- 5. The blood of Jesus Christ is our ONLY way to salvation.
- 6. If we were saved by our works, why did Christ have to die?
- 7. The scarlet thread of blood that flows through all the sacred scriptures is first seen by us in Genesis 3:21 and flows clear to the last chapter of Revelation.

"THE PRECIOUS BLOOD OF CHRIST"

1. The **Preeminence** of Christ's Blood.

Hebrews 9:11–12, NASB95 - ¹¹ But when Christ appeared *as* a high priest of the good things to come, *He entered* through the greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this creation; ¹² and not through the blood of goats and calves, but through His own blood. He entered the holy place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.

Hebrews 9:11–12, TLB-¹¹ He came as <u>High Priest of this better</u> system that we now have. He went into that greater, perfect tabernacle in heaven, not made by men nor part of this world, ¹² and <u>once for all took blood into that inner room, the Holy of Holies, and sprinkled it on the mercy seat;</u> but it was not the blood of goats and calves. No, <u>he took his own blood</u>, and with it he, by himself, <u>made sure of our eternal salvation</u>.

2. The **Power** of Christ's Blood.

Hebrews 9:13–14a, NASB95 - ¹³ For if the blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkling those who have been defiled sanctify for the cleansing of the flesh, ¹⁴ how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God....

Hebrews 9:13–14a, TLB - ¹³ And if under the old system the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of young cows could cleanse men's bodies from sin, ¹⁴ just think how much more surely the blood of Christ will transform our lives and hearts.

3. The **Purpose** of Christ's Blood.

Hebrews 9:14b, NASB95 - ¹⁴ ...cleanse your conscience [meaning, we have to get over something] from dead works [the works we do thinking they will save us; only Christ's blood saves us] to serve the living God?

Hebrews 9:14b, NASB95 – ¹⁴ Having <u>won for us men eternal</u> <u>reconciliation with God</u>...<u>by offering himself to God as the perfect</u> sacrifice....
