<u>STUDY VERSE - Philippians 1:10, NASB</u> - ¹⁰ so that you may <u>approve</u> [lit., discern after a deep study] the things that are <u>excellent</u> [lit., highest worth, Jesus used this word in Matt. 6:26 when He asked, "Aren't you <u>much more valuable</u> than (the birds in the air)..."], in order to be <u>sincere</u> [lit., sun-judged or approved, "like a shining splendor as of the sun" (Wuest)] and <u>blameless</u> [lit., not stumbling despite a gale, no accusation about personal sin, pure] <u>until</u> the <u>day of Christ</u> [cf., Our Lord will soon return to rapture the church and judge the world—we must be ready for that moment]....

Philippians 1:10, NLT - ¹⁰ For I want you to understand <u>what really matters</u>, so that you may live pure and blameless lives until the day of Christ's return.

Philippians 1:10, NCV - ¹⁰ that you will see the difference between good and bad and will choose the good; that you will be pure and without wrong for the coming of Christ....

Philippians 1:10, TLB - ¹⁰ for I want you always to <u>see clearly the difference</u> <u>between right and wrong</u>, and to be inwardly clean, no one being able to criticize you from now until our Lord returns.

Philippians 1:10, GWT – I want you to be able always to recognize what really matters and what really doesn't so you might live blameless lives because the Lord's return in at hand
