# Study Section — Philippians I:II

Philippians 1:10–11, NLT - <sup>10</sup> For I want you to understand what really matters, so that you may live pure and blameless lives until the day of Christ's return.

<sup>11</sup> May you always be <u>filled</u> [lit., a continual filling (surrender)] with the <u>fruit</u> [rf., an outward evidence of an inward change;' JOY and RIGHTEOUSNESS (in part) would be that fruit] of your salvation—the <u>righteous character produced</u> [the word "produced' does not appear in the GK; it is implied because "Jesus Christ" is in the Genitive Case. This 'filling' comes from Jesus] in your life by Jesus Christ—for this will bring much glory and praise to God.

### 1. God's purposes are often accomplished through our problems.

**Philippians 1:12, NLT** - <sup>12</sup> And I want you to know, my dear brothers and sisters, that everything that has happened to me here has helped to spread the Good News.

In troubled times, don't complain about "What God did not do;"
Anticipate "What God is going to do."

# 2. God's purposes should always be our goal.

**Philippians 1:13, NLT** - <sup>13</sup> For everyone here, including the whole palace guard, knows that I am in chains <u>because of Christ</u>.

**2 Timothy 2:9, ESV** - <sup>9</sup> ... I am suffering, <u>bound with chains</u> as a criminal. But the word of God is not bound!

In troubled times, share Christ with the lost.

### 3. God's purposes should shine through every aspect of our lives.

**Philippians 1:14, NLT** - <sup>14</sup> And because of my imprisonment, most of the believers here have gained confidence and boldly speak God's message without fear.

In troubled times, seek to have the courage of other believers.
