# REVELATION The Future unveiled Marriage Made

## Four Reasons to shout "Hallelujah!"

### 1. The power of God has vanquished \_\_\_\_\_

Revelation 19:1–2, NIV84 - ¹ After this I heard what sounded like the roar of a great multitude in heaven shouting: "Hallelujah! ["Hallelujah", OT in origin: HEB: הֵלְלוֹדְיָה, it simply means, "Praise the Lord" (Hal-lel means "praise", Yah is short for "Jehovah"; its used only in this passage in the NT, the Greek form is "alleluia" (19:1, 3, 4, 6) Three groups cry "Hallelujah" before Holy God: The saints in Heaven (vv. 1-3), the elders before the throne (v. 4), and the great multitude (v. 6)] Salvation and glory and power belong to our God, ² for true and just are his judgments. He has condemned [lit, vanquished—destroyed forever] the great prostitute who corrupted the earth by her adulteries. He has avenged on her the blood of his servants."

### 2. The \_\_\_\_\_ Reigns!

Revelation 19:3–6, NIV84 - <sup>3</sup> And again they shouted: "Hallelujah! The smoke from her [destroyed Babylon] goes up for ever and ever." <sup>4</sup> The twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God, who was seated on the throne. And they cried: "Amen, Hallelujah!" <sup>5</sup> Then a voice came from the throne, saying: "Praise our God, all you his servants, you who fear him, both small and great!" <sup>6</sup> Then I heard what sounded like a great multitude, like the roar of rushing waters and like loud peals of thunder, shouting: "Hallelujah! For our Lord God Almighty reigns [lit., "to be enthroned as King"]."

### 3. The Marriage of the \_\_\_\_\_ has come!

**Revelation 19:7–8, NIV84** - <sup>7</sup> "Let us rejoice and be glad and give him glory! For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and his bride has made herself ready. <sup>8</sup> Fine linen, bright and clean, was given her to wear." (Fine linen stands for the righteous acts of the saints.)

Ephesians 5:25–28, NIV84 - <sup>25</sup> Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her <sup>26</sup> to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, <sup>27</sup> and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless. <sup>28</sup> In this same way, husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself.

### 4. The Marriage supper \_\_\_\_\_\_.

**Revelation 19:9, NIV84** - <sup>9</sup> Then the angel said to me, "Write: '<u>Blessed</u> are those who are invited to the wedding supper of the Lamb!' " And he added, "These are the true words of God."

**Revelation 19:9, The Living Bible** - <sup>9</sup> And the angel dictated this sentence to me: "Blessed are those who are invited to the wedding feast of the Lamb." And he added, "God himself has stated this."

### Bonus: God \_\_\_\_\_ is to be worshipped!

**Revelation 19:10, NIV84** - <sup>10</sup> At this I fell at <u>his</u> [the angel's] feet to worship <u>him</u> [the angel]. But <u>he</u> [the angel] said to me, "Do not do it! I am a fellow servant with you and with your brothers who hold to the testimony of Jesus. <u>Worship God!</u> For the testimony of Jesus is the <u>spirit of prophecy</u> [a reference to the OT; in other words, the main theme of the OT prophecy, as well as the NT is this: **Jesus is the Messiah!!!]**."

**Revelation 19:10, NLT** - <sup>10</sup> Then I fell down at his feet to worship him, but he said, "No, don't worship me. I am a servant of God, just like you and your brothers and sisters who testify about their faith in Jesus. Worship only God. For the essence of prophecy is to give a clear witness for Jesus."
