Psalm 22 tells of the Savior's <u>Cross</u>. Psalm 23 tells of the Shepherd's <u>Crook</u>. Psalm 24 tells of the Sovereign's <u>Crown</u>.

A. He's the God of <u>everyday</u> needs.

Psalm 23: 1-3, NASB -¹ The LORD is my shepherd, I shall not want. ² He makes me lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside quiet waters. ³ He restores my soul; He guides me in the paths of righteousness For His name's sake.

B. He's the God of emergency needs.

Psalm 23, 4-5, NASB -⁴ Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. ⁵ You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You have anointed my head with oil; My cup overflows.

C. He's the God of eternal needs.

Psalm 23, 6, NASB - ⁶ Surely goodness and lovingkindness will follow me all the days of my life, <u>And I will dwell in the house of the LORD</u> forever.
