# A. WHY DID JESUS COME TO EARTH?

## 1. To Satisfy the Prophecies.

**Luke 24:25–27, NASB95** - <sup>25</sup> And He said to them, "O foolish men and slow of heart <u>to believe in all that the prophets have spoken</u>! <sup>26</sup> "Was it not necessary for the Christ to suffer these things and to enter into His glory?" <sup>27</sup> Then beginning with Moses and with all the prophets. He explained to them the things concerning Himself in all the Scriptures.

#### 2. To Show us the Father.

John 14:9, NASB95 - 9 ...He who has seen Me has seen the Father....

### 3. To Save us from Sin.

1 Timothy 1:15, NASB95 - <sup>15</sup> It is a trustworthy statement, deserving full acceptance, that <u>Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners</u>, among whom I am foremost of all.

# 4. To Sympathize with our Struggles.

**Hebrews 4:15, NASB95** - <sup>15</sup> For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tempted in all things as *we are, yet* without sin.

# 5. To Secure our Hope.

**John 14:6, NASB95** - <sup>6</sup> Jesus said to him, "<u>I am the way</u>, and the truth, and the life; <u>no one comes to the Father but through Me</u>.

## **B. GOD'S LOVE**

Od showed how much He loved us by sending His one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through Him. <sup>10</sup> This is real love—not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins. <sup>11</sup> Dear friends, since God loved us that much, we surely ought to love each other.

## 1. The Origin of God's Love.

**1 John 4:9, NLT** - <sup>9</sup> God showed how much he loved us <u>by sending his one and only Son into the world</u> so that we might have eternal life through him.

**1 John 4:9, NCV** - <sup>9</sup> This is how God showed his love to us: <u>He sent his one and only Son into the world</u> so that we could have life through him.

**John 3:16, NASB95** - <sup>16</sup> "For God so loved the world, that <u>He gave His only begotten Son</u>, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

Christmas is the moment God's Love took on human flesh and walked among us.

#### 2. The Power of God's Love.

**1 John 4:10, NASB95** - <sup>10</sup> In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son *to be* the propitiation for our sins.

**Hebrews 2:17, NLT** - <sup>17</sup> Therefore, it was necessary for him to be made in every respect like us... <u>Then he could offer a sacrifice that would</u> take away the sins of the people.

Romans 3:24–25, NASB95 - <sup>24</sup> being <u>justified</u> as a <u>gift</u> by <u>His grace</u> through <u>the redemption which is in Christ Jesus</u>; <sup>25</sup> whom God displayed publicly as a <u>propitiation in His blood through faith</u>....

God's Love Gift of Jesus was not wrapped in gold but in humility—a manger, not a palace.

## 3. The Mission of God's Love.

**1 John 4:11, NASB95** - <sup>11</sup> Beloved, if <u>God so loved us</u>, <u>we also ought to love one another</u>.

God's Love doesn't just comfort us—it changes us.

The birth of Jesus Christ was the beginning of a <u>rescue</u> <u>mission of love</u> to bring hope, healing, and eternal life.
