

Hebrews 10:19–25, NIV84 - ¹⁹ Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, ²⁰ by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, his body, ²¹ and since we have a great priest over the house of God, ²² let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water. ²³ Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. ²⁴ And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. ²⁵ Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching. A Study of Hebrews 10:19-25

You don't need a local church to be saved, but you need the church to live life like you are saved. - Pastor Joe

1. Let us DRAW NEAR.

Hebrews 10:22, NIV84 - ²² <u>let us draw near to God</u> with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water.

2. Let us HOLD FAST.

Hebrews 10:23, NASB95 - ²³ Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful....

3. Let us LIFT UP each other.

Hebrews 10:24, NIV84 - ²⁴ And let us consider how <u>we may spur</u> one another on toward love and good deeds.

Hebrews 10:24, LBP - ²⁴ In response to all he has done for us, <u>let us outdo each other in being helpful and kind to each other</u> and in doing good.

4. Let us MEET TOGETHER.

Hebrews 10:25, NASB95 - ²⁵ not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging *one another;* and all the more as you see the day drawing near.
