**2 Corinthians 12:7–10, NLT** – [Paul said] <sup>7</sup> ... even though I have received such wonderful revelations from God. So to keep me from becoming proud, <u>I was given a thorn in my flesh</u>, a messenger from Satan to torment me and keep me from becoming proud. <sup>8</sup> Three different times I begged the Lord to take it away. <sup>9</sup> Each time he said, "<u>My grace is all you need</u>. My power works best in weakness." So now I am glad to boast about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ can work through me. <sup>10</sup> That's why I take pleasure in my weaknesses, and in the insults, hardships, persecutions, and troubles that I suffer for Christ. For when I am weak, then I am strong.
