## Gospel – Jesus lived, died, & rose to life for you.

Love -

- No Fear
- No Condemnation
- No Insecurity
- No Shame

This all leads to Humble Honesty.

Humble Honesty leads to a willingness to extend Grace & Honor to others because that's how God's loved us.

As we have a heart of grace & honor toward those around us, The Gospel directs us to Forgive & Live Forgiven.

It is then that we can start to Rebuild Trust.

All of this can only happen when we have a Dependent Community.

1. Depend on
• Their devotion to the "apostles' teaching" pointed them to Jesus.
• Their devotion to the "fellowship, the breaking of bread, and the prayers" all led them to greater & greater delight in Christ.
We're called by God to live dependent upon the Gospel—to depend on Christ.

- (1) Know what God's blessed you with—it could be a talent, time, or some sort of physical gift.
- (2) Get to know the people of the church and what they need.

Our dependence upon Christ & one another is primarily expressed and increased by our gathering together.

# A Gospel-directed community is a dependent community.

To live dependent upon the Gospel so that we know how much we're loved...

- We're living in humble honesty...
- We're living with hearts of grace & honor toward others...
- We're confident that we're forgiven & living forgiven...
- We're rebuilding trust...

As we depend on Christ & one another we'll become a Gospeldirected community.
