❖ **FREEDOM PRINCIPLE ONE: REST in what God has done for you.**

- We Cannot Save Ourselves
 - Salvation and freedom comes from what Jesus has done for you, not what you or I might do for Him.
 - We don't earn God's love, we are invited to enjoy it, experience it, and to embrace it.
- God Offers Rest

❖ **FREEDOM PRINCIPLE TWO: RESPOND with a life empowered by the Spirit.**

- It is not the absence of restraints that makes us free.
- There is no freedom in life until one belongs to God.
(Galatians 5:22-23)

❖ **FREEDOM PRINCIPLE THREE: REACH OUT by becoming contagious.**
