- 8. How can a person practically humble himself or herself?
- 9. What lessons can we learn about nations and rulers from Daniel 4?
- 10. How can you protect yourself from developing pride?

- 12. What are some ways to honor God based on what Daniel says to King Nebuchadnezzar?
- 13. Seeing as King Nebuchadnezzar essentially writes Daniel 4, what do you think about a foreign king writing scripture?

- 14. Examine yourself and pray for God to reveal to you any pride. Confess and repent from your pride.
- 15. When others praise you, get into the habit of redirecting that praise back to God.
- 16. Remember the ABCs of humility: Admit your need, Bend your will, Confess God's greatness.
- 17. Make it a daily discipline and priority to praise God, even around other people.
