- 4. How can a person grow in his or her faith in God?
- 5. How might it look different to consider the Christian life as a marathon rather than a sprint?
- 6. While God's affections for us are not affected by our obedience, what is affected by our obedience or disobedience?
- 7. What are some ways we can fix our eyes on Jesus?

Personal Application:

- 8. What are some things that are slowing you down as you run the race of the Christian life? Surrender these things to God. Some possibilities might be: ungodly relationships, entertainment, hobbies, sports or comforts.
- 9. Confess and repent of your sins that you have been holding onto.
- 10. Release those sins that you have already repented of and remember the gospel.
- 11. Are your eyes regularly fixed on Jesus? What are your eyes usually fixed on in a normal day? What practical things can you do to remind yourself to fix your eyes on Jesus?
