- 6. What are some evils that you could honestly say that you hate?
- 7. Application: What are some evils that you tolerate that you probably should hate?
- 8. How does David's prayer at the end of Psalm 139 connect with the rest of the psalm?
- 9. Would you hesitate to ask God to examine your heart and reveal it to you? Why or why not?
- 10. Why do some Christians neglect God's evaluation of them?
- 11. What good or evil has God affirmed or challenged in you over the past few weeks?
- 12. How aware are you of the sin in your life? How does awareness of personal sin relate to love?
- 13. **Application:** Pray the prayer at the end of Psalm 139 again this week and journal which things God reveals to you. Be prepared to share some of these the next time you meet.
