Discussion Questions:

1. What were some things that stood out to you from this past week's sermon?

4. Why might we not want others to know things about us?
5. What might be scary about God knowing everything about you?
6. If God already knows everything, what might it tell us about God that He *searches* out our paths?
7. *Dig Deeper:* What are some areas of your life where you might try to push God out?
8. If God already knows what we think before we say anything, why should we pray?
9. How often do you feel that you don't know yourself well? How might this message help you understand yourself better?
10. How often do you stop saying something wrong simply because you know that God knows your words?
11. How might God remembering our words be a way for Him to show that He loves us?
12. In what ways did Pastor Mike say that God could use our words to defend us?
13. What does it mean to say that God hems us in?
14. **Share:** What are some ways that you have seen God protect you or someone you love?
15. **Application:** Pray David's prayer in Psalm 139:23-24 daily for the next week
