Discussion Questions:

1. What were some things that stood out to you from this past week's sermon?

2. If you could summarize the basic message from this past week's sermon, what was it?

3. **Share**: What kind of things has God revealed to you over the past few weeks as you have been praying the prayer at the end of Psalm 139?

4. What are some things that prevent us from doing the things that we want to do?

5. If God is capable of doing all things, how can we explain the bad things that happen to us?

6. *Dig Deeper*: Are there some parts of yourself that you feel are not valuable? How does this sermon speak to that?

7. Since God skillfully knits us together in the womb, how do we account for birth defects?

8. Like David, do you know in your soul that you have been fearfully and wonderfully made?

9. These verses from Psalm 139 are often quoted by Christians, how have these verses made an impact in your life before?

10. **Application**: Since everyone is knit together in the womb, how can this affect the way we value other people?

11. How does it make you feel to know that God has ordained the details of your life? Are you more prone to find comfort or be afraid?

12. **Share**: Can you think of a time when you could clearly see God working out all the little details of your life to lead you somewhere?

13. **Application**: Find someone this week who is difficult to deal with, pay attention to how God has uniquely made them and praise God for His creative power.

14. **Application**: In your time in the tent this week, be purposeful to praise God for the unique way that God has made you.
