- 9. Have you ever been frustrated because you longed for transformation but it hasn't come? According to 2 Corinthians 3:18, what do we need for transformation?
- 10. How can we behold Jesus' glory now if He is in heaven?
- 11. Is it possible to read your Bible but miss God's glory? How can you read your Bible in a way that helps you behold God's glory more?
- 12. In what ways might we veil God's glory in our lives?
- 13. **Application:** Do something this week to make sure you see God's glory, be ready to share what happened next week as well as the effect on others.
