Dig Deeper:

- 1. What difficulties would this woman have faced with this bleeding issue?
- 2. How do you think other people would have reacted to this woman in the crowd?
- 3. When in your life have you felt shame? Did you reach out to anyone in that shame?
- 4. What is the significance of the fringe of a rabbi's garment? What did it represent?
- 5. What do you think would have been the typical response of a rabbi if this woman touched him? Why do you think she reached out to Jesus in particular?
- 6. What promises of God might this woman be clinging to here?
- 7. When Jesus says "Go in peace", after healing the woman, what unique meaning might that have for her?

Application:

- 8. Reach out to the Lord in prayer, in worship, in the word, or in community.
- 9. Find someone who loves to study the word and reach out to them this week.
- 10. Have you lost hope recently? Learn from the woman and reach out to Jesus right now.
- 11. Confess your sins to God and even a godly brother or sister this week.
