Discussion QuestionsLuke 3:15-22: The STAR of the Show

1. Read Luke 3:15-16 . Discuss the reasons why John the Baptist says the messenger is not as important as the Messiah. Why is that significant and how does John's example challenge us?
2. John said Jesus would baptize "with the Holy Spirit and fire." Jesus sends the Holy Spirit a few days after He ascends to heaven (Acts 2). Based on Luke 3:17 , while the 'fire' could refer to purifying believers, why does the context seem to be referring to the baptism of fire as judgment?
3. Read Luke 3:18-20 . Why was John imprisoned and why should contemporary believers prepare themselves for persecution (see 2 Tim. 3:12-13)? Name some reasons why we should risk challenging people to turn from their sin and trust Jesus.
4. Read Luke 3:21 & Luke 12:50 . Beyond just being an example for us to follow, what did the baptism of Jesus represent?
5. Read Luke 3:21-22 . How does this passage speak to the reality of the Trinity? ('Trinity' is NOT a biblical word. It is a Latin term meaning tri-unity or 3-in-1) What is the danger of 'modalism' and how does this prove modalism as false?
6. What impacted you the most from today's teaching (or throughout this series thus far)?
7. Pray for one another & ask God for opportunities to share Jesus & develop disciples.
