

# Christ or Culture? (1 John 2:12-17)

Christians across the world are experiencing a tug-o-war for their affections. Today we're challenged to answer this question: *Will we follow Christ or Culture?*

#### **Encouraging Words to Different Maturity Levels**

<u>1 John 2:12–13</u> (CSB) I am writing to you, little children, since your sins have been forgiven on account of his name. I am writing to you, fathers, because you have come to know the one who is from the beginning. I am writing to you, young men, because you have conquered the evil one.

#### Children Forgiven

When we REALLY BELIEVE that our **sins have been** fully **forgiven**, <u>our lives will be transformed</u>! Remember the story of the loving Father and prodigal son? Look at the Father's response to the son's return home!

<u>Luke 15:21–24</u> ...'Father, I have sinned against heaven and in your sight. I'm no longer worthy to be called your son.' "But the father told his servants, 'Quick! <u>Bring out the best robe and put it on him</u>; put a <u>ring on his finger</u> and <u>sandals on his feet</u>. Then bring the fattened calf and slaughter it, and **let's celebrate with a feast**, because **this son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found!**' So they began to celebrate.

✓ Oh how that son must have felt! Guilty...yet FORGIVEN!!!! Unworthy...yet CELEBRATED!!!!

#### Fathers Know Jesus

The longer your relationship lasts with a friend or a spouse, the better you know them. So too, those who have walked with Jesus for a long time, know His heart and start to act/react as He would. (The apostle Paul writes that followers of Jesus <u>are being comforted into the image of Jesus</u> - see Rom 8:29).

#### Young Men Defeat the Devil

These **young men** are <u>no longer children in the faith,</u> but not yet fathers in the faith, but they are maturing, passionate followers of Jesus who submit to God and resist the devil (James 4:7), and are prepared to stand against the devil's schemes (Eph 6:11) by living in faith, speaking the truth, and trusting what Jesus says.

Revelation mentions those who stand in the face of the Devil's deception of the world.

<u>Revelation 12:11</u> They conquered him [Satan] by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony; for they did not love their lives to the point of death.

<u>1 John 2:14</u> I have written to you, children, because **you have come to know the Father**. I have written to you, fathers, because you have come to know the one who is from the beginning. I have written to you, young men, because you are strong, **God's word remains in you**, and you have conquered the evil one.

Much of this is similar, but some of it is different.

- Children (young believers) aren't just forgiven; they also **know the Father**.
- Once again, John notes that <u>fathers</u> have come to know the one who is from the beginning.
- John encourages the young men conquering the devil with these words: **you are strong** and that **God's word remains in you**. When **God's word** the message of Jesus and the truths of God is permeating our lives and influencing our daily decisions, we can stand against the enemy too!

**Do you value God's words found in the Scriptures?** When is the last time you opened the Scriptures and read them? **Does God's word remain in you?** And what's your EVIDENCE for your answer?

#### Follow Christ over Culture

<u>1 John 2:15</u> Do <u>not</u> love the world or the things in the world. <u>If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.</u>

How can God love the world yet tell us not to (Remember John 3:16)? **World** comes from the Greek **kosmos** (pr. kōse-mōse). This word, like many others, means different things in different contexts. Some words have different meanings and the context helps clarify the meanings.

#### KOSMOS/world...

- 1. can refer to <u>created universe with order, arrangement, & adornment</u>. This is where we get the word **cosmetics** from to order, arrange, or adorn.
- 2. can refer to **people alienated from God**—how it is used in John 3:16 God so loved 'the world'.1
- 3. can refer to <u>cultural practices of godless society</u>. 2 <u>culturally acceptable worldview without God in the mix</u>.

#### Simply Put: 'World' can mean

Q Planet, People on the planet, Philosophy of the People on the Planet

John is speaking of <u>loving the cultural practices of godless society or the culture's = PHILOSOPHY.</u>

There is a contrast here: **Love of the world** versus **Love of the Father**. To love *the world* is *incompatible* with loving God. We must make a DECISION. **Will we love & follow our Culture or love & follow our Creator?** 

#### Caught in the Cultural Drift?

<u>1 John 2:16-17</u> For everything in the world—the <u>lust of the flesh</u>, the <u>lust of the eyes</u>, and the <u>pride in one's possessions</u>—is not from the Father, but is from the world. And the world with its lust is passing away, but **the one who does the will of God remains forever**.

#### Lust of the Flesh

The **lust of the flesh** is a REAL battle going on inside the believer - *our sinful desires versus our spiritual desires*. Paul gives a substantial list of actions and attitudes that are "fleshly".

<u>Galatians 5:19–21</u> Now the works of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, moral impurity, promiscuity, idolatry, sorcery, hatreds, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambitions, dissensions, factions, envy, drunkenness, carousing, and anything similar. I am warning you about these things—as I warned you before—that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

#### Lust of the Eyes

**GOD** gave us our eyes. These same incredible gifts that allow us to see millions of colors, and all the beauty and scenery that God has created - including the people we love! **Yet these same eyes can lead us to disobedience** and discontentment.

#### Pride in One's Possessions

- Some translate this as the *pride of life* [NAS, ESV, NIV], but the term for "life" is better understood as "possessions, property, livelihood",<sup>3</sup> as the CSB & NET translate.
- Our homes, possessions, positions, & prestige are GIFTS from God. How it must sadden God when the stuff we
  own causes us to BOAST instead of BLESS, to be prideful instead of thankful.
  - <u>Pride causes us to value our possessions above God and people</u>. We really think we are somehow more important because of what we own...but one day that's going away...or you are.
  - Know how to tell if you're prideful? You glory in your stuff, your beauty, or your reputation.
