## Jesus, Friend of Sinners

Luke 5:27-39

## **Luke 5:27–39** (NIV)

<sup>27</sup> After this, Jesus went out and saw a tax collector by the name of Levi sitting at his tax booth. "Follow me," Jesus said to him, <sup>28</sup> and Levi got up, left everything and followed him. <sup>29</sup> Then Levi held a great banquet for Jesus at his house, and a large crowd of tax collectors and others were



eating with them. <sup>30</sup> But the Pharisees and the teachers of the law who belonged to their sect complained to his disciples, "Why do you eat and drink with tax collectors and sinners?" <sup>31</sup> Jesus answered them, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. <sup>32</sup> I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance." <sup>33</sup> They said to him, "John's disciples often fast and pray, and so do the disciples of the Pharisees, but yours go on eating and drinking." <sup>34</sup> Jesus answered, "Can you make the friends of the bridegroom fast while he is with them? <sup>35</sup> But the time will come when the bridegroom will be taken from them; in those days they will fast." <sup>36</sup> He told them this parable: "No one tears a piece out of a new garment to patch an old one. Otherwise, they will have torn the new garment, and the patch from the new will not match the old. <sup>37</sup> And no one pours new wine into old wineskins. Otherwise, the new wine will burst the skins; the wine will run out and the wineskins will be ruined. <sup>38</sup> No, new wine must be poured into new wineskins. <sup>39</sup> And no one after drinking old wine wants the new, for they say, 'The old is better.'"

## <u>Discussion Questions</u> Luke 5:27-39: Jesus, Friend of Sinners

1. <b>Read Luke 5:27-29</b> Of all the types of people Jesus could call as a disciple, what is the significance of Jesus calling Levi (aka Matthew) the tax collector?
2. Levi's home was a place where Jesus is honored and people were welcomed. Why is inviting someone into your home different than just inviting them to a large church gathering? How could you better use your home as a tool for the King? Explain your answer.
3. <b>Read Luke 5:30-39</b> . What does this passage tell you about why the Pharisees clashed with Jesus? Why did the Pharisees criticize Jesus instead of applaud Him?
4. BIG TRUTH: <u>Jesus calls people From Sin to Follow Him</u> . Levi couldn't continue to cheat others AND follow Jesus too. He had to choose one or the other. How would you answer the person who says, "I want Jesus but I want my sin too."?
5. What is it that impacted you from today's teaching? Explain your answer.
