Luke 2:41-52: The Greatest Goal

Luke 2:41-50 (NIV)

⁴¹ Every year Jesus' parents went to Jerusalem for the Festival of the Passover. ⁴² When he was <u>twelve years old</u>, they went up to the festival, according to the custom. ⁴³ After the festival was over, while his parents were returning home, the boy Jesus stayed behind in Jerusalem, but they were unaware of it. ⁴⁴ Thinking he was in their company, they traveled on for a day. Then they began looking for him among their relatives and friends. ⁴⁵ When they did



not find him, they went back to Jerusalem to look for him. ⁴⁶ After three days they found him in the temple courts, sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions. ⁴⁷ Everyone who heard him was <u>amazed at his understanding and his answers</u>. ⁴⁸ When his parents saw him, they were astonished. His mother said to him, "Son, why have you treated us like this? Your father and I have been anxiously searching for you." ⁴⁹ "Why were you searching for me?" he asked. "Didn't you know I had to be **in my Father's house**?" ⁵⁰ But they did not understand what he was saying to them.

Luke 22:70–23:1 (NIV)

- ⁷⁰ They all asked, "**Are you then the Son of God?**" He replied, "You say that I am."
- ⁷¹ Then they said, "Why do we need any more testimony? We have heard it from his own lips." ¹ Then the whole assembly rose and led him off to Pilate.



Luke 2:51-52 (NIV)

⁵¹ Then he went down to Nazareth with them and was obedient to them. But his mother treasured all these things in her heart. ⁵² And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man.
