¹⁶ "No one lights a lamp and hides it in a clay jar or puts it under a bed. Instead, they put it on a stand, so that those who come in can see the light. ¹⁷ For there is nothing hidden that will not be disclosed, and nothing concealed that will not be known or brought out into the open.



Matthew 10:26-27

²⁶ "So do not be afraid of them, for there is nothing concealed that will not be disclosed, or hidden that will not be made known. ²⁷ What I tell you in the dark, speak in the daylight; what is whispered in your ear, proclaim from the roofs.

¹⁹ Now those who had been scattered by the persecution that broke out when Stephen was killed traveled as far as Phoenicia, Cyprus and Antioch, spreading the word only among Jews. ²⁰ Some of them, however, men from Cyprus and Cyrene, went to Antioch and began to speak to Greeks also, telling them the good news about the Lord Jesus. ²¹ The Lord's hand was with them, and a great number of people believed and turned to the Lord.

Luke 8:16-21: Genuine Disciple or Just Disguised?

1. Is it possible that Americans have diluted the Biblical idea of what it means to be a disciple of Jesus? Explain your answer.
2. Read Luke 8:16-17, Matthew 10:26–27, & Acts 11:19-21. Based on these passages, what would you say to the person who claims to be a disciple of Jesus who refuses to share the LIGHT of Jesus with others?
3. Read Luke 8:18 . Now go back & read the context: Luke 8:12-15 . What is this passage (v.18) talking about?
 4. BIG TRUTH: Genuine Disciples Listen, Love, & Share God's Word. (1) What distractions can keep you from listening to God's Word? How often do read the Scripture? (2) Read Psalm 119:97–104. King David loved God's Word. What are some principles in this passage that could help us learn to love & cling to God's Word? (3) Share the names of some folks you need to share God's Word withthen PRAY for them by name & ask God to give you boldness to share with them.
5. Read Luke 8:19-21. Based on our study & this passage, what are some characteristics that demonstrate whether a person is a Genuine Disciple or Just Disguised?
6. What does God want YOU to do with what we studied today?
