A Call to Selfless Humility | Philippians 2:1-4 Pastor Scott | September 27, 2020

<u>Main Point of Philippians</u>: This book contains the mind-set, attitude, and outlook the believer must have if he or she is going to experience the joy of the Lord in a troubled world.

The Truths (v. 1)

Truth #1: Is there any encouragement from belonging to Christ?

John 14:16: "And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, [Comforter/Encourager] who will never leave you."

Truth #2: Any comfort from his love?

2 Corinthians 1:3-4: "All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. God is our merciful Father and the source of all comfort. He comforts us in all our troubles so that we can comfort others. When they are troubled, we will be able to give them the same comfort God has given us."

Truth #3: Any fellowship together in the Spirit?

Truth #4: Are your hearts tender and compassionate?

Strange Request (v. 2a): Then make me truly happy...

The "Do" Responses (v. 2b)

Do Response #1: by agreeing wholeheartedly with each other

Do Response #2: loving one another

Do Response #3: working together with one mind...

Do Response #4: working together with one mind and purpose.

The "Don't Responses" (vv. 3-4)

Don't Response #1: Don't be selfish

Don't Response #2: don't try to impress others

Don't Response #3: Don't look out only for your own interests

- Ephesians 5:29-"No one hates his own body but feeds and cares for it, just as Christ cares for the church.")
- 1 Timothy 5:8-"But those who won't care for their relatives, especially those in their own household, have denied the true faith. Such people are worse than unbelievers.").

Application #1 (v. 3): Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves.

Application #2 (v. 4): but take an interest in others, too

Closing Word:

-What's the secret to a good life? Selfless humility
