"The Story: Paul's Missions" | Pastor Scott

Paul's mission of taking Christ's message to the ends of the earth is our mission too.

1. The church is the body of Christ in the World. 1 Corinthians 12

A. Assembled together, the church is Jesus' body, we are to think like Jesus, act like Jesus, and love others like Jesus. 1 Corinthians 12:27

B. The church is commissioned to go into all the world as witnesses to Jesus. Acts 1:8

Acts 1-7: Jerusalem

Acts 8-12: Judea/Samaria Acts 13-28: Ends of the Earth

C. God wants all people in the uttermost parts of the earth to hear the good news of salvation in Jesus Christ. Romans 1:16

2. God raises up a leader to take the Gospel to the ends of the earth: Paul.

A. Saul of Tarsus was an unlikely candidate to become the world's first and most renowned missionary. Acts 9; 1 Corinthians 15:9

B. Paul's Strategy

Went to Jews first. Acts 13:27-33a, 38-39

Went to Gentiles second. Acts 13:46-47

Start where they are... Acts 17:22-34

C. Paul planted 10 churches and wrote 13-14 of the 27 New Testament books. Acts 19:20; 2 Corinthians 11:24-28

3. Themes in Paul's Writing. A. Maturity:
One of Paul's earliest messages was to GROW UP! 1 Corinthians 3:1-3; Galatians 5:1
A healthy church will always have believers at every level of maturity in the spectrum. Hebrews 5:12, 14
B. Unity: 1 Corinthians 1:10; 12:25
Christian maturity produces unity in the church.
Unity is not uniformity.
<u>C. Biblical Worldview:</u>1 Corinthians 15:3-4; Romans 12:2; 2 Corinthians 10:5; 2 Timothy 2:23
D. Daily Living:
Galatians 5:16-25.
