John 1:1-5;

*In the beginning the Word already existed.
The Word was with God,
and the Word was God.*

² He existed in the beginning with God.

*⁴ The Word gave life to everything that was created,

²⁰ But in fact, Christ has been raised from the dead. He is the first of a great harvest of all who have died.

For Sinful Mankind:

Acts 4:12;

There is salvation in no one else! God has given no other name under heaven by which we must be saved."

...Therefore, we will...

Response #1: Trust Him:

Hebrews 4:14-16;

So then, since we have a great High Priest who has entered heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to what we believe. ¹⁵ This High Priest of ours understands our weaknesses, for he faced all of the same testings we do, yet he did not sin. ¹⁶ So let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive his mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it most.

John 14:6

Jesus told him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me.

Response #2: Take this good news to the world:

Luke 4:16-19;

¹⁶ When he came to the village of Nazareth, his boyhood home, he went as usual to the synagogue on the Sabbath and stood up to read the Scriptures. ¹⁷ The scroll of Isaiah the prophet was handed to him. He unrolled the scroll and found the place where this was written:

*¹⁸ "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me,
for he has anointed me to bring Good News to the poor.*

*He has sent me to proclaim that captives will be released,
that the blind will see,*

that the oppressed will be set free,

¹⁹ and that the time of the Lord's favor has come."

Matthew 28:18-20;

Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹ Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations,^[a] baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. ²⁰ Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Acts 1:8;

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Mark 16:15

And then he told them, "Go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone.

2 Corinthians 5:17-21

¹⁷ This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!

¹⁸ And all of this is a gift from God, who brought us back to himself through Christ. And God has given us this task of reconciling people to him. ¹⁹ For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And he gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation. ²⁰ So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!" ²¹ For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.
