Acts 16:6-40

First three believers in Philippi:

Name	Ethnicity	Economic Class	Spiritual State	Ministry Approach
Lydia	Asian	Wealthy	God-fearer	Words
Slave Girl	Native Greek	Poor	Turmoil	Deeds
Jailer	Roman	Blue Collar	Practical and indifferent	Example

Ten years later... Paul is sitting on house arrest in Rome. Epaphroditus brings support and news; Paul writes back, with joy in his heart!

This book contains the mind-set, attitude, and outlook the believer must have if he or she is going to experience the joy of the Lord in a troubled world.

Mentions of joy in Philippians 16x

**A Joy-filled Christian belongs to Jesus (1:1a)**

**A Joy-filled Christian is involved in a local church (1:1b)**

**A Joy-filled Christian has their identity order correct (1:1c)**

**A Joy-filled Christian receives grace and experiences peace (1:2)**

**A Joy-filled Christian gives thanks, often (1:3)**

**A Joy-filled Christian prays expectantly (1:4)**

**A Joy-filled Christian partners with others for the advance of the gospel (1:5)**
