A Healthy, Life-Giving Church | 1 Peter 3:8-12

In today's passage, we see ten characteristics of a healthy-life-giving church.

⁸ Finally, all of you should be of one mind. Sympathize with each other. Love each other as brothers and sisters. Be tenderhearted, and keep a humble attitude.

1. One Mind: commitment to unity and harmony. NOT perfect agreement in everything.

1 Corinthians 2:16- "For, 'Who can know the Lord's thoughts? Who knows enough to teach him?' But we understand these things, for we have the mind of Christ."

2. Sympathize: responsive to others needs.

3. Love each other: seeing and treating each other as brothers and sister.

4. Be Tenderhearted: affectionately sensitive and caring.

5. Keep a humble attitude: willing to encourage and celebrate another's success.

⁹ Don't repay evil for evil. Don't retaliate with insults when people insult you. Instead, pay them back with a blessing. That is what God has called you to do, and he will grant you his blessing.

6. No Revenge:

*¹⁰ For the Scriptures say,
"If you want to enjoy life
and see many happy days,
keep your tongue from speaking evil
and your lips from telling lies.*

7. Watch your tongue

Psalms 141:3- "Take control of what I say, O Lord, and guard my lips daily."

8. Tell the Truth: Satan is the father of lies. no truth in him. deception. falsehood. undermine the sanctity and truth of God.

*¹¹ Turn away from evil and do good.
Search for peace, and work to maintain it.*

9. Turn from Evil & Do Good

10. Peacemaker

*¹² The eyes of the Lord watch over those who do right,
and his ears are open to their prayers.
But the Lord turns his face
against those who do evil.”*
