We believe:

God the Father:

What He Does [just a sample...]

Creator-Genesis 1:1: *“In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.”*

Sent His Son-John 3:16-17: *“For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. ¹⁷ God sent his Son into the world not to judge the world, but to save the world through him.”*

Who He Is

One Living

One: Deuteronomy. 6:4: *“Listen, O Israel! The Lord is our God, the Lord alone.”*

1 Corinthians 8:4-6: *So, what about eating meat that has been offered to idols? Well, we all know that an idol is not really a god and that there is only one God. ⁵ There may be so-called gods both in heaven and on earth, and some people actually worship many gods and many lords. ⁶ But for us, There is one God, the Father, by whom all things were created, and for whom we live. And there is one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom all things were created, and through whom we live.*

Isaiah 44:6: *“This is what the Lord says—Israel’s King and Redeemer, the Lord of Heaven’s Armies: “I am the First and the Last; there is no other God.”*

Living- John 5:26: *“The Father has life in himself, and he has granted that same life-giving power to his Son.”;*

Loving- 1 Jn 4:7-12: *“Dear friends, let us continue to love one another, for love comes from God. Anyone who loves is a child of God and knows God. ⁸ But anyone who does not love does not know God, for God is love. ⁹ God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. ¹⁰ This is real love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins. ¹¹ Dear friends, since God loved us that much, we surely ought to love each other. ¹² No one has ever seen God. But if we love each other, God lives in us, and his love is brought to full expression in us.”*

Faithful-Deuteronomy. 4:29-31: *“But from there you will search again for the Lord your God. And if you search for him with all your heart and soul, you will find him. ³⁰ In the distant future, when you are suffering all these things, you will finally return to the Lord your God and listen to what he tells you. ³¹ For the Lord your God is a merciful God; he will not abandon you or destroy you or forget the solemn covenant he made with your ancestors.”*

Just (Holy)- “Holy” means to be set apart, to be unique.

Our holy God cannot look on evil because our sin absolutely disgusts God. (Habakkuk 1:13: *“But you are pure and cannot stand the sight of evil. Will you wink at their treachery? Should you be silent while the wicked swallow up people more righteous than they?”*; Revelation 3:16: *“But since you are like lukewarm water, neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth!”*); Psalm 95:10-11: *“For forty years I was angry with them, and I said, ‘They are a people whose hearts turn away from me. They refuse to do what I tell them.’¹¹ So in my anger I took an oath: ‘They will never enter my place of rest.’”*),

God hates sin and cannot turn a blind eye to it. Romans 3:23: *“For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God’s glorious standard.”*; Romans 6:23: *“For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God’s glorious standard.”*

God will not compromise His holiness by indulging our sinful behavior.

Our Responses

#1: Delight in His goodness:

Deuteronomy 6:4-5: *““Listen, O Israel! The Lord is our God, the Lord alone.⁵ And you must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your strength.”*

Goodness: Acts 14:17- *“but he never left them without evidence of himself and his goodness. For instance, he sends you rain and good crops and gives you food and joyful hearts.”*

#2: Surrender to His Will:

Isaiah 43:10-11: *““But you are my witnesses, O Israel!” says the Lord. “You are my servant. You have been chosen to know me, believe in me, and understand that I alone am God. There is no other God—there never has been, and there never will be.¹¹ I, yes I, am the Lord, and there is no other Savior.”*

2 Timothy 3:15-16: *“You have been taught the holy Scriptures from childhood, and they have given you the wisdom to receive the salvation that comes by trusting in Christ Jesus.¹⁶ All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right.”*

We submit/surrender to His will because of who HE is Matthew 6:10: *“May your Kingdom come soon. May your will be done on earth, as it is in heaven.”*

John 6:38: *“For I have come down from heaven to do the will of God who sent me, not to do my own will.”*
