Confession

Why Confession?

Greatest Commandment from Matthew 22: Love God!

(Romans 3:23; Romans 6:23; 1 John 1:9; Proverbs 28:13; James 4:8)

Neil Anderson writes in *Bondage Breaker*, “Unacknowledged sin is like cancer cells. If they are caught at an early stage of growth through regular check ups, the prognosis is good; but if they’re left to grow undetected, the prognosis is bad. Living in the light and holding ourselves accountable to God on a daily basis prevents major spiritual crisis” (p. 168).

What is Confession?

“Admission, especially of guilt or sin; also a statement of religious belief. ‘To confess’ can mean to agree, to promise, or to admit something.” –*Baker Encyclopedia of the Bible*

“To own, acknowledge or avow, as a crime, a fault, a charge, a debt, or something that is against one's interest, or reputation.” –*Webster's 1828 Dictionary*

Agree with God about your actions, thoughts, and speech. – *Gil Stieglitz*

Two Type of Confession

1. Of Faith

2. Of sin

OT Practice: Day of Atonement

NT Practice: 1 John 1:5-2:2

Church Practice: Corporate and Individual

Confession (Done in detail and as soon as possible)

Forsaking (sorrow for sin, requires help from God)

(Webster, 1828): “To quit or leave entirely; to desert; to abandon; to depart from”

Three Crucial Elements of Confession

1. It must be ongoing.
2. It must acknowledge personal guilt.
3. It occasionally includes repentance and a plan.
