In today's passage, we see Jesus' submission contrasted with Peter's self-reliance.

Spiritual Horror

-Wrath of God as Jesus was made sin. 2 Corinthians 5:21: *"For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, [become sin itself] so that we could be made right with God through Christ."*

-Bear the curse of the law. Galatians 3:13a: *"But Christ has rescued us from the curse pronounced by the law. When he was hung on the cross, he took upon himself the curse for our wrongdoing."*

Jesus Submits to the Father's Plan; Peter Succumbs to Temptation (14:43-52)

-We don't fight spiritual battles with physical weapons. 2 Corinthians 10:3-5: "*We are human, but we don't wage war as humans do. ⁴ We use God's mighty weapons, not worldly weapons, to knock down the strongholds of human reasoning and to destroy false arguments. ⁵ We destroy every proud obstacle that keeps people from knowing God. We capture their rebellious thoughts and teach them to obey Christ.*"

Complete isolation of Jesus. Amos 2:16: "*On that day the most courageous of your fighting men will drop their weapons and run for their lives, ' says the Lord.*"
